With the increased use of fertility drugs and procedures and women waiting later in life to start a family (both of which increase the chances of multiple birth), this trend can only continue to experience growth. "We felt that we could not only cover the technical and medical aspects of raising multiples with authority; but just as importantly, we had many experienced mothers and fathers to draw from for all other aspects of rearing multiples. We wanted to be sure we included 'regular' parenting tips as well as multiple-specific tips," adds Dr. Moskwinski, mother of six children including twin girls.
